Dear colleagues,

Thank you very much for your solidarity and support that is so needed this difficult time.

For three weeks of the Russian aggressive war on the territory of Ukraine, several thousand civilians including over 100 children have been killed. The exact figures are still to be clarified and may be much higher. Thousands of residential buildings, enterprises, hospitals, about 400 educational institutions (300 schools) have been damaged or completely destroyed by bombing and shelling.

Millions of people have lost their homes and livelihood, and do not have any food and clothes.

Catastrophic humanitarian situation has occurred in the cities of the Eastern and Central parts of Ukraine: Kharkiv, Mariupol, Chernihiv, Izum and other cities and villages that are under siege and continuous shelling.

Those who were lucky to leave these places alive had lost everything they had.

There are several millions refugees fleeing to Western Ukraine and further to the EU.
